

POLICY NAME:	105.01: Technical/Community College Designation

CROSS REFERENCE:	

1. Each postsecondary technical institution shall be designated as a technical college on its own merits when the following conditions have been met:
 - 1.1. The institution should submit a request to the State Board of Education endorsed by a resolution from the institutional local advisory committee;
 - 1.2. The institution should be accredited by the Commission on Occupational Education Institutions of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools;
 - 1.3. The institution should meet the requirements for a minimum number of approved degree programs;
 - 1.4. All programs of the institution leading to the associate in applied technology degree should undergo a visiting team review by a committee of persons currently engaged in occupations related to the training program;
 - 1.5. All curricula alterations for previously approved associate in applied technology degree programs in the institution should be reviewed by a local program advisory committee and approved by the State Board of Education.

2. Upon the approval of the State Board of Education and with the recommendation of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools and the Chancellor, an institution serving its community in both academic and vocational-technical training may be named "community college."
