1. The operation, direction, and control of the Adult Education Program of the state, including the Basic Skills Education Program and the associated Workplace Tax Credit Program, are vested with the Chancellor under the supervision of the State Board of Education and, in accordance with appropriate statutes, all elements of *Administrative Code* to the contrary are hereby repealed and replaced by policy of the Board.
2. Adult Education Program services shall be integrated with System institutions in order to fulfill the purposes of the program as set forth by law and according to the direction of the Chancellor, under the supervision of the State Board of Education.
3. That document associated with the Adult Education Program commonly referred to as the Tests of General Education Development shall in Alabama be officially titled, "The State of Alabama High School Equivalency Diploma."
4. As necessary, the Chancellor shall issue guidelines for the administration and enforcement of the provisions of the programs.
