



Dear GED Tester,

Once you have successfully met Alabama's Test of General Educational Development (GED) score requirements, you are entitled to a waiver for **one free credit course** (up to 3 hours) at any of the Alabama Community College System's two year institutions.

ACCS member institutions can assist you in earning an associate's degree, taking a few courses, getting remedial education, or gaining workforce skills. Eighty percent of the new jobs available in the next decade will require a minimum of two years of postsecondary education making Alabama's two-year colleges more important to you than ever. You may obtain a listing of Alabama's two-year colleges from your local testing center, or by visiting www.accs.cc, to help you choose the institution you may wish to attend.

It is important to remember, that once you successfully complete your GED, you will receive one free electronic copy of your GED Transcript sent to your email address. Once you receive the transcript in your email, you will have **60 days** to download and save the transcript. During the 60 days, you may download the transcript 7 times for free. You will want to **save the transcript** so it will be convenient for you to access when you need to provide copies to colleges, training centers, employers, etc. You may save the transcript on your computer's hard drive, on a jump- drive, on the Cloud, on your desktop, or by other electronic means.
